We provide trash bags and compost bags. Additionally, volunteers will receive free gifts for participating, such as tree seedlings, water bottles and tote bags.

WHEN IS THE DEBRIS PICKED UP?

All trash and compost will be picked up by Rizzo Services on the Monday following the event at each cleanup location.

Limit of five (5) boxes of office grade paper.
